An experience like nowhere else on Earth

AN EXTRAORDINARY ADVENTURE TO THE SOUTHERNMOST PART OF THE WORLD BRINGS FORTH COLOSSAL ICEBERGS, UNBELIEVABLE SEASCAPES, AND THE UNPREDICTABLE NATURE THAT POLAR EXPLORERS SPENT THEIR LIVES TRYING TO CONQUER.

AN ICY WONDERLAND at the end of the world, which for many centuries wasn't explored and became the subject of admiration and obsession of the first world expeditioners, Antarctica only acquired its official name in the 1800s, a Romanized version of its Greek title, which actually means 'opposite to the North'.

For some experienced travelers, Antarctica is the crème de la crème when it comes to exploring the world, not just because of its remote location, its difficult access and challenging temperatures, but also because it is the only non-inhabited continent in our planet (apart from a small research station, even now when some other areas are over populated).

Antarctica has no indigenous population and there is no evidence that it was seen by humans until the 19th century. The many expeditions aiming to be the first to reach the South Pole in the 1900s provide us with stories of survival and wondrous adventures worthy of high acclaim in the history books

Although this vast stretch of the planet remains the stuff of distant dreams for many, its mysterious nature is reachable due to the reduction in sea ice during the summer months, which our strong, ice-classed expedition vessels, Ocean Victory and Albatros can easily maneuver, ensuring we get close to the dramatic coastlines.

Zodiac cruising and shore landings are an important and considerable part of the planned itinerary, enabling all expedition guests to set foot several times on the Antarctic continent, as well as the many surrounding sub-Antarctic islands.

Can you visualize the splendor of the coldest continent appearing before your eyes? With its mighty tabular icebergs, it is a sight like no other. Not only will we cross the unbelievable Drake Passage, but we will also have the opportu-

nity to witness the white shimmer of Antarctica looming on our horizon, the presence of wildlife multiplying by tens of thousands with many species of lively penguins, inquisitive seals, nesting birds and the spray of marine mammals. The sub-Antarctic and Antarctic islands are a nature photographer's paradise.

Antarctica's beauty exceeds everything imaginable. Vastly different from the Arctic, 98% of the Great White Continent is covered in ice with glaciers, smooth ice-sheet and glaciated mountains with volcanoes. Crisp white icebergs and deep blue seas, flank the barren, rocky coastlines, which are home to moss, lichens, liverworts and even two small flowering plants – the Antarctic pearl wart and Antarctic hair grass. The sub-Antarctic islands and Falklands have tundra-like landscapes.

Due to the harsh climate, there are no terrestrial mammals, yet a plethora of wildlife still call Antarctica home – at least in the warmer summer months when temperatures hover just above freezing! The prolific birdlife, penguin colonies and marine mammals, such as whales, porpoises and seals, provide rewarding wildlife observation.

There will typically be crisp, autumn-like weather in Patagonia and the Falkland Islands, and near-freezing temperatures on the Antarctic Peninsula. Antarctica is a frozen desert where winds shape the surface of snow and ice, and average annual precipitation is only 10cm.

When Ocean Victory and Albatros return to Tierra del Fuego and Ushuaia, we pass close to the mythical Cape Horn - the southernmost point of South America; a celebrated maritime landmark. By the time you return home from this remarkable journey, your perspective of our planet will have changed forever, and we are certain the sights and experiences of this trip will find a special place in your heart.

From whale sightings to bird watching, the Arctic wildlife can truly be admired from so many different vantage points. Our expedition cruise from Reykjavík to Kangerlussuag will allow you to experience Iceland's geysers, an immensity of impressive land and sea scapes, the ever-present Northern fulmar sea bird, and a multitude of otherwise inaccessible settlements in both Iceland and Greenland, with modern Inuit communities.

From around April to August, the summer's midnight sun bathes Greenland, Svalbard and Iceland in sunlight, increasing the average daily temperatures to comfortable, crisp conditions. If your journey continues to Oslo or Copenhagen, expect warmer days with a mixture of sunshine, rain and refreshing breezes.

During the short summer, wildlife such as reindeer are busy amassing energy for the icy polar winter. These are excellent months to visit if you enjoy photography and activities such as fishing and hiking.

But what if your dream is to follow the footsteps of the first explorers and visit the remote North of the world?

We also offer an early summer's cruise from the green islands of Scotland and North Atlantic to the Arctic islands of Jan Mayen and Svalbard. We will go north together with the migrating birds, and hopefully spot polar bears hunting from the sea ice in 24-hours of daylight.

SVALBARD - THE LAST STOP BEFORE THE NORTH POLE

ENJOY THE IMMENSE BEAUTY of Svalbard on this Arctic adventure cruise among whales, walruses, polar bears and millions of sea birds. Experience high summer in the Arctic with Ocean Albatros.

One of the goals of this Albatros expedition is to sail as close as possible to the pack ice north of Svalbard - the polar bear's favorite summer residence. How far north we reach and the exact route up there will depend on the ice conditions. Additionally, we will visit several of the amazing locations along the west coast of Svalbard, all kept navigable by the warm Gulf Stream.

During the short summer, wildlife such as reindeer and polar foxes are busy amassing energy for the icy polar winter. The cliffs shimmer with life as every surface is populated with countless birds, and in a few months a new generation of arctic sea birds are ready to leave their nests. Arctic guillemots, black guillemots and razorbills can be observed fishing in the wake of our ship. On several shores, the huge walruses enjoy the short Arctic summer as well as many whales and seals foraging along the edge of the pack ice and the coasts.

We approach the polar bear's favorite summer residence, as we cruise to 80 degrees north, getting as close as possible to the pack ice north of Svalbard. How far north we reach, and the exact route will depend on the ice conditions, but fortunately many amazing locations along the coasts of Svalbard's islands are kept navigable by the warm Gulf Stream.

Onboard our brand-new vessel, Ocean Albatros, you will experience areas of Svalbard not easily accessible otherwise, as we circumnavigate Spitsbergen to reach the seldom visited places in Hinlopen Strait as well as Edgeøya and the secluded fjords of Bellsund and Hornsund in the far south.

Our Zodiac expedition boats allow us to venture closer to shore and make landings along the spectacular coastlines.





THE FOUR ARCTIC ISLANDS

THIS EPIC JOURNEY combining the four islands of Spitsbergen, Jan Mayen, Greenland, and Iceland showcases the uniqueness and splendour of the Arctic nature.

Onboard our brand-new vessel, Ocean Albatros, we venture out of Longyearbyen aiming for the northeast corner of Spitsbergen. As well as make Zodiac landings, we hope to get close to the pack ice coming down from the North Pole - the favourite hunting ground for polar bears.

On our way to Greenland, we will cruise along the pack ice before continuing to the enigmatic Jan Mayen Island. From here it is onwards to Ittoqqortoormiit (Scoresbysund) and the deep fascinating fjord system. We will be crossing the Denmark Strait to the capitol of Iceland, Reykjavik, before disembarking right in the city centre.

Enjoy the immense beauty of the Arctic on this adventure cruise among whales, walruses, polar bears, and millions of sea birds. Experience high summer in the Arctic with Ocean Albatros - one of the few iceclass expedition ships built to withstand the North Pole's pack ice.

Reykjavík to Kangerlussuaq, following the same maritime course set by Norse settlers over a thousand years ago. Our vessel will be the brand-new Ocean Albatros. Just as Eric the Red on his voyage from Iceland, we will experience the stark contrast from the lofty and glaciated East Coast to the green, fertile West Greenland. A fact that prompted him to call his new home "Greenland". Our first call is the natural wonder, Fjord of Skjoldungen in southeast Greenland. Prince Christians Sound leads us safely from the rugged east coast through 100 km of mountainous landscapes to West Greenland. We will make landing at Qassiarsuk, at the spot where Eric settled, before we reach Nuuk, the capital of Greenland. Get up early to get the first glimpse of giant icebergs flowing slowly into Davies Strait from Disko Bay. Here we visit the small town of Qegertarsuag, make a stop in front of the huge Eqi Glacier, and take a walk in Ilulissat to the World Heritage Site of the Icefjord. Our last stop along the coast will be the small settlement of Sarfannguit, before we enter the long fjord of Kangerlussuaq, where it is possible to join a trip through the tundra to the Greenland Icecap before your home bound flight. An enriching experience of Greenlandic culture and Arctic nature.

IN THE WAKE OF ERIK THE RED





GREENLAND - DISKO BAY

TRAVELLING BY SEA is still the best way to experience Greenland. The places most worth seeing are situated along the dramatic coastline: small and colourful houses resting on the steep mountain sides down to a fjord, giant glaciers producing enormous icebergs, meanwhile whales and seals play in the sea. And only a few minutes' hike away you will find yourself totally alone, surrounded by wilderness. But global warming is changing Greenland's Arctic environment at an alarming rate. On this 8 day voyage to Disko Bay and Uummannag, we follow the tracks of scientists and decision makers to see with our own eyes the retreating glaciers and gasp at the thought of losing them. During our third day of the cruise, we visit the Danish Research Station on Disko Island. Climate experts in our Expedition Team will lead a series of scientific lectures and discussions on board to shed a light on one of the hottest topics of our time. We will utilize Zodiacs for beach landings, settlement visits and enjoy nature hikes to get close to receding glaciers. We reach our northernmost point at the fabulous town of Uummannaq, before heading back south for a Zodiac cruise at Eqip Sermia, a giant retreating glacier. We will then head further on to Ilulissat, the Iceberg Capital of the World. Our last call will be at the small Inuit settlement of Sarfannguit.

Heading out from Reykjavík, our first call is the isolated Inuit community, Ittoggortoormiit. From here we navigate into the overwhelming Kong Oskar Fjord, which acts as a gateway for the North Greenland National Park, the world's largest nature reserve.

Navigating the sheltered interior of the National Park's fjord system, we are likely to enjoy stable September weather with clear skies and distant views. Snow dusts the mountain tops, and the supernatural wonders of Aurora Borealis can be seen at night.

We make landings at century old hunting stations in breathtaking landscapes, as our ship navigates north around Ella and Ymer Islands into Kejser Franz Joseph Fjord. On the southbound voyage, we will aim for Carlsberg Fjord and the dramatic Blosseville Coast, with plans to make landings near the great fjord of Kangerlussuaq.





INTO THE NORTHWEST PASSAGE

ALBATROS EXPEDITIONS LAUNCHES a new and unique voyage which combines the dramatic and wild Arctic Canada around Baffin and Ellesmere Island with the colourful settlements along northwest Greenland. Guests will experience the Arctic where adventurers of the past sought the Northwest Passage and through which the Greenlandic explorer, Knud Rasmussen travelled on his longest sledge journey 100 years ago.

The journey begins in Kangerlussuaq in West Greenland, from where we cruise west to the Inuit land of Nunavut on Baffin Island. Inuit have lived on this coast for millennia, and during our voyage to the north we will visit several small settlements. It was from here that Inuit migrated to Northwest Greenland 1000 years ago and created the basis for the modern Greenlandic population. We will constantly be on the lookout for polar bears, narwhal and the numerous bowhead whales feeding off Baffin's coasts in September.

From Baffin Island we will steer into Lancaster Sound, the start of the Northwest Passage, and then head back to Greenland. We will visit Qaanaaq, the northernmost inhabited town in the world, and continue further down the west coast to Upernavik, Uummannaq and Ilulissat. Finally we reach Kangerlussuaq after an expedition voyage that encompasses the wide range of Arctic nature and its fascinating population.

Ocean Albatros's modern design and technical features ensure high safety and ultimate comfort in demanding Arctic waters, making it the perfect vessel for this voyage.






